An abstract summarizes the major aspects of a paper. It should succinctly summarize the purpose of the paper, the methods used, the major results, and conclusions.

Author should follow the following guidelines. The extended abstract should be written in MS Word format in single-spaced in 12-point Times New Roman except for abstract. Do not indent the text paragraphs. Each paragraph must be a single-spacing separated (Click icon '¶' at the Home Tools). The in-text citation of the manuscript should be in numbered (Vancouver) with a square bracket '[]' only.

Authors are requested to submit the extended abstracts in electronic form (MS-Word) via our Online Submission. Please ensure the extended abstract has a **minimum of 4** pages and maximum of 5 pages in the length excluding the references. The pages

**should not be numbered**. The incorrect formats may result in your abstract being returned to you by e-mail. The scientific committee will select the contributions for oral and poster presentations.


